A large non-profit is identified as a non-profit with an annual budget of \$100,000.00 or more. A small non-profit is identified as a non-profit with an annual budget of less than \$100,000.00. For hourly prizes awarded based on the highest number of "individual donors," individuals who donate more than once within the hour will not be counted twice.
